Wind and rain can damage the E-Z UP<sup>®</sup> Instant Shelter<sup>®</sup> and may also result in injury to you or others. Therefore, do not rely on shelter for protection in heavy or prolonged rain storms.
- Do not use shelter in a lightning storm.
- The E-Z UP® Instant Shelter® is designed as a temporary shelter. Do not leave up for extended periods.
- Do not leave your E-Z  $\text{UP}^{\circledast}$  Instant Shelter^ $\circledast$  unattended.
- Keep all flame and heat sources away from fabric top. Do not build fires within shelter enclosure.

# CARE AND MAINTENANCE

For long lasting durability and the best possible protection for your E-Z UP^ Instant Shelter\*, follow these E-Z care and maintenance instructions:

- Use a mild soap (not detergent) and water with soft brush for top cleaning.
- Let the E-Z UP  $^{\otimes}$  top and frame especially inner legs dry completely before closing or storing to avoid mildew.
- Frame will operate and look better if occasionally wiped with silicone spray, especially before and after use in damp conditions. Remove excess silicone residue before applying top.
- You can use a seam sealer if top leaks or drips water. Available at most sporting goods and hardware stores.
- Slightly tighten bolts if frame becomes loose.

# WHAT'S IN THE BOX

- 1 10' x 10' Frame Fully Assembled 4 Piece Stake Set
- 1 Polyester Top
- 1 Cover/Carry Bag

## HOW TO SET UP

Please read each step before you attempt to set up. Save these instructions for future reference.

\*Note: First Time Top Attachment Is Required. Top and frame are shipped unattached to avoid damage. This first time set up takes longer than future set ups. Once top is attached to frame, set up and take down are easily accomplished within seconds.



**1** • Place your E-Z UP<sup>®</sup> frame in the center of area to be shaded. With partner on opposite side, grasp two outer legs, slightly lift off ground and step backwards, stopping at full arms' length.



2. Gently unfold the fabric top and place it over the open frame.



**3.** Attach the top to the E-Z UP<sup>®</sup> frame by matching Velcro<sup>®</sup> strips on the top with the Velcro<sup>®</sup> strips on the frame. Push the Velcro<sup>®</sup> firmly together at each corner.



**4.** With partner on opposite side of shelter, stand diagonally facing one another by the "open" and "close" stickers located on the trusses. Grasp the top and bottom of the diamond shaped area of trusses on opposite sides by "open" stickers. Lift up and step backward until shelter is 3/4 opened, being careful not to pinch fingers.



**5.** To engage the auto slider at each corner, first lift the fabric off of the slider, then with one hand hold the top of the leg while pushing up on the slider with the other hand. The pull pin will engage the hole. Pull down the fabric valance over the slider. Repeat on all four corners.



**6.** Lift outer legs up and slide out the inner legs until the snap button locks into the outer leg. Repeat on the opposite legs.

Note: Once top is attached, only perform steps 1 and 4 - 6 to set up.

# How To Take Down



**1**. With partner, slightly lift up two adjacent outer legs, depress snap button and telescope inner legs into outer legs. Repeat on the opposite legs.



2. Release pull pin at each corner by first lifting valance fabric away from slider. With one hand push up on truss near the pull pin, pull the pin out to release. Note: It is much easier to release pull pin when the shelter weight has been removed from the pull pin.



**3.** Grasp the top and bottom of diamond on diagonally opposite sides by "close" sticker. Lift the shelter up slightly and shake it while stepping towards your partner until the unit is 3/4 closed. With each partner grasping two outer legs, push frame together to fully close it. Be careful not to pinch fingers.

**<sup>4.</sup>** Place cover/carry bag over the shelter.
