- Always stake or weight down your E-Z UP® shelter. Do not use in any potentially windy or rainy weather. Wind and rain can damage your E-Z UP® shelter and may also result in injury to you or others. Therefore, do not rely on shelter for protection in heavy or prolonged rain storms.
- The E-Z UP® shelter is designed as a temporary sun shelter. Do not leave up for extended periods.
- Use caution when handling the E-Z UP® frame. Avoid pinching hands or fingers as frame opens or closes.
- Do not use shelter in a lightning storm.
- Do not leave your E-Z UP® Instant Shelter® product unattended.
- Do not build fires under shelter.

**WARNING:** Keep all flame and heat sources away from the top, awning and sidewall fabrics. These fabrics meet the flammability requirements of CPAI-84. The fabric may burn if left in continuous contact with any flame source. The application of any foreign substance to the fabric may render the flame-resistant properties ineffective.

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

For long lasting durability and the best possible protection for your E-Z UP® Instant Shelter® product, follow these E-Z care and maintenance instructions:

- Use a mild soap (not detergent) and plenty of water for top cleaning.
- Let the E-Z UP® top and frame dry completely before closing or storing to avoid mildew.
- Frame will operate and look better if occasionally wiped with silicone spray, especially before and after use in damp conditions. Remove excess silicone residue before attaching top.
- Use a seam sealer if top leaks or drips water. Available at most sporting goods and hardware stores.
- Slightly tighten bolts if frame becomes loose.

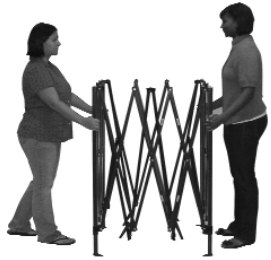

# WHAT'S IN THE BOX

- Pagoda™ Frame
- Two-Tone Polyester Top
- Roller Bag
- 4 Piece Stake Kit

## FIRST TIME TOP ATTACHMENT

Please read each step before you attempt to set up. Save these instructions for future reference.



**1.** Place your Pagoda™ frame in the center of area to be shaded. With partner, grasp two outer legs, slightly lift off the ground, and step backwards, stopping at full arms' length.



**2.** Spread the Top Vent Fabric over the peak section and slide the 4 fabric corners over the 4 Vent Fingers.

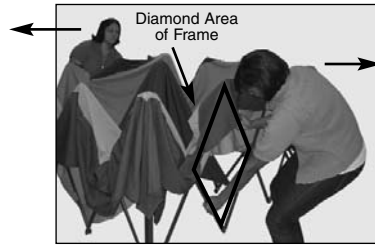


**3.** Expand the frame to approx. 2/3 open. Spread the larger fabric over the frame, tuck the fabric under the Top Vent Fabric Fingers and using the hook and loop strips, secure the top to the trusses at 8 different points.



**4.** Attach the larger fabric to the frame by matching hook and loop attachment straps on the top with the hook and loop strips on the frame. Push firmly together at each corner.

# How To Set Up



**1.** With partner on opposite side of shelter, grasp the top and bottom of the diamond shaped area of truss on opposite sides. Lift up and step backward until shelter is 3/4 opened, being careful not to pinch fingers. Expand frame to fully open. MAKE SURE THE VENT FINGERS ARE RELEASED OVER LARGE FABRIC.



**2.** To engage Pull Pin Slider at each corner, first lift the fabric off of the slider, then with one hand hold the top of the leg while pushing up on the slider with the hand. The Pull Pin will engage the hole. Repeat on all four corners.

**3.** A) Insert extension rods in the top of the legs. B) Secure corner fabric to the leg by inserting the 2 clips into the small holes at the top of each leg. C) Finally, pull the fabric out over the end of the extension rods and secure using the sewn pockets. Repeat on all four corners.



**4.** Lift outer legs up and slide out the inner legs until the snap button locks into the outer leg. Repeat on the opposite legs.



# How To Take Down

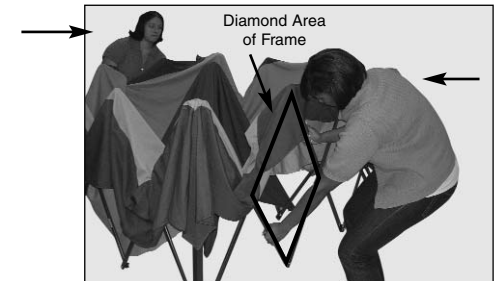


**1.** With partner, slightly lift up two adjacent outer legs, depress snap button and telescope inner legs into outer legs. Repeat on the opposite legs.

**2.** Now, with the shelter in lowered position, remove extension rods. A) Pull the fabric back out from the sewn pockets to gain access to extension rods. B) Remove fabric by releasing the 2 clips from the small holes at the top of each leg. C) Carefully slide extension rods out from the top of the legs. Repeat on all four corners.



**3.** Release Pull Pin at each corner by first lifting valance fabric away from slider. With one hand push up on truss near the Pull Pin, pull the pin out to release. NOTE: It is much easier to release Pull Pin when the shelter weight has been removed from the Pull Pin.



**3.** Grasp the top and bottom of diamond shaped truss by the close labels. Lift the shelter up slightly and shake it while stepping towards your partner until the unit is 3/4 closed. With each partner grasping two outer legs, push frame together to fully close it. Be careful not to pinch fingers! Store shelter in roller bag.
